Selected memoirs and peace messages will be included in this year's Peace Declaration. Furthermore, all the memoirs and messages will be compiled in a booklet and used as documents to transmit the reality of the atomic bombing, such as through distribution to the city's junior/senior high schools.

- When used in the Peace Declaration or other documents in order to spread the reality of the atomic bombing, parts of the memoirs and messages might be quoted, or the wording of certain expressions may be changed.
