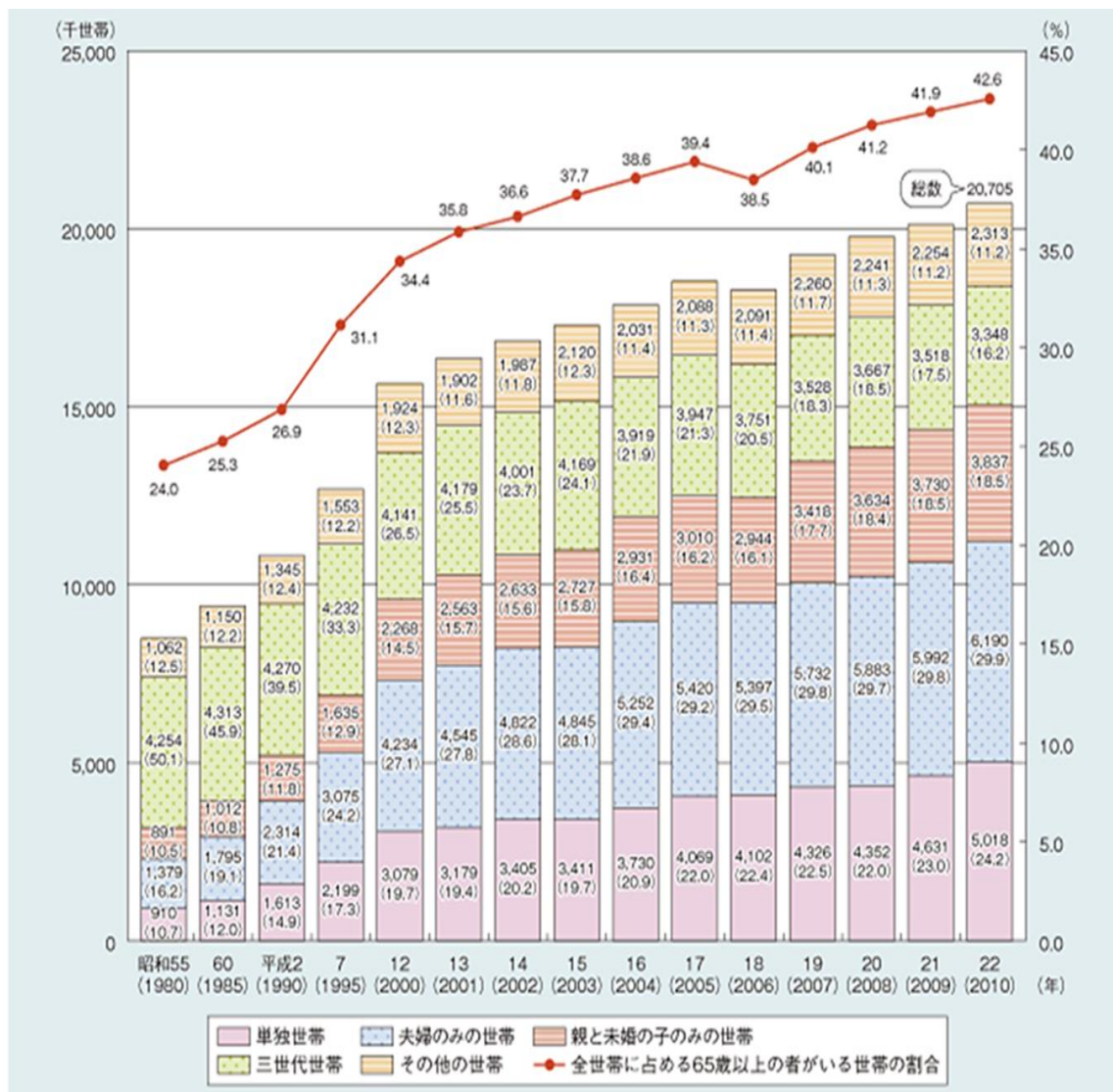

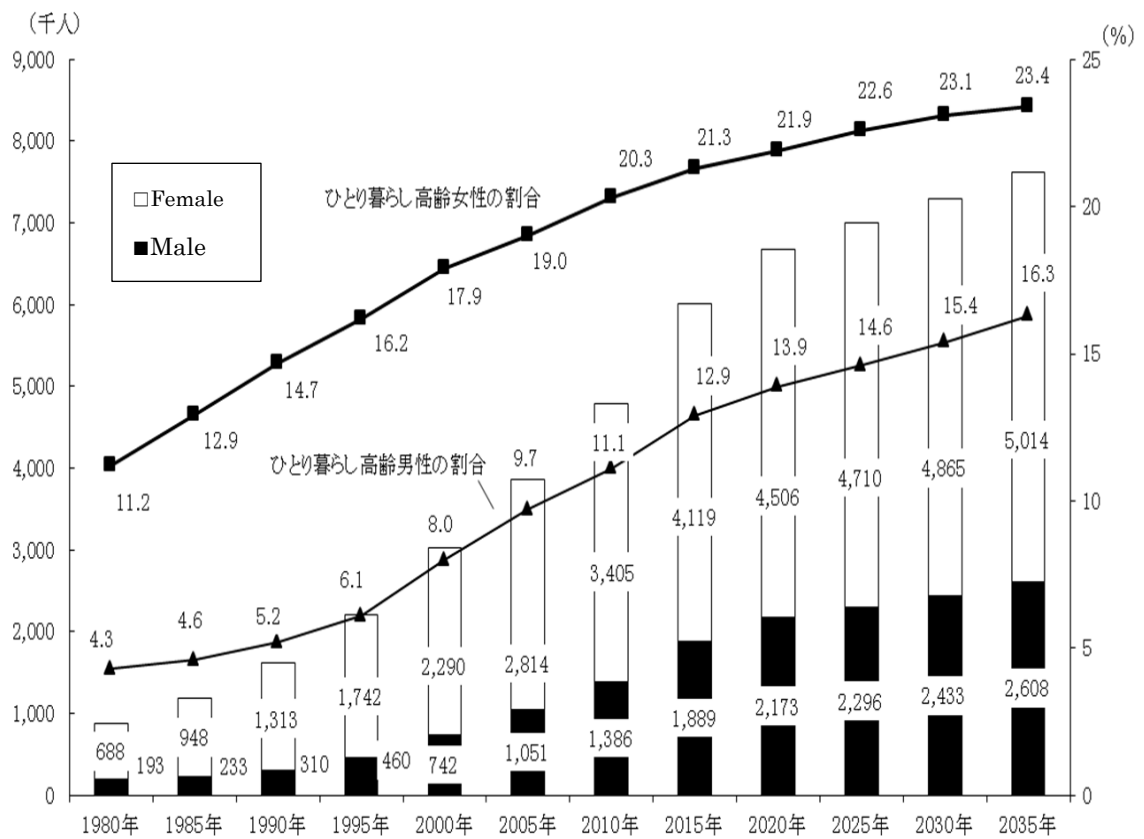
Table 1: Household structures for people aged 65 and over

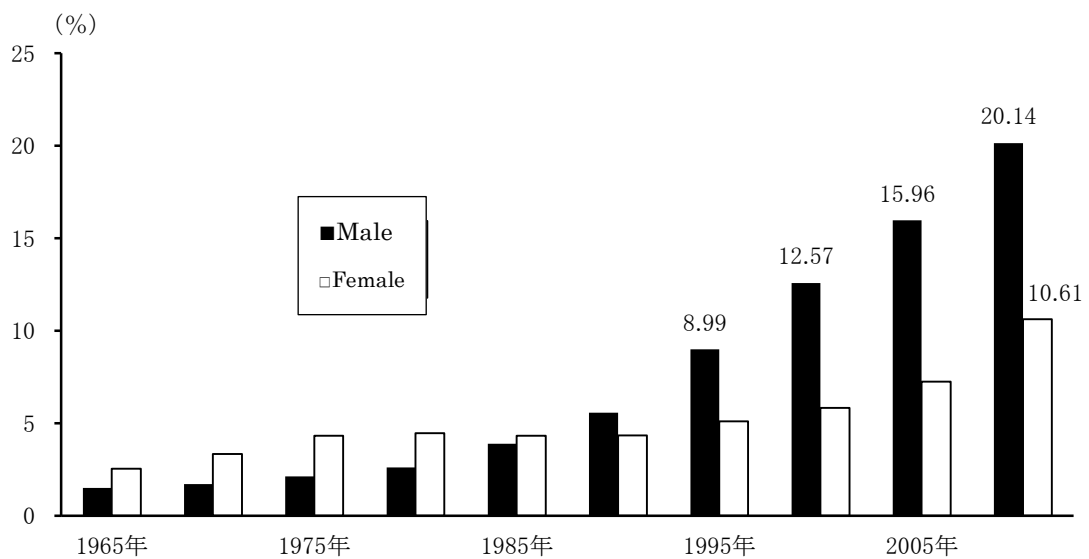

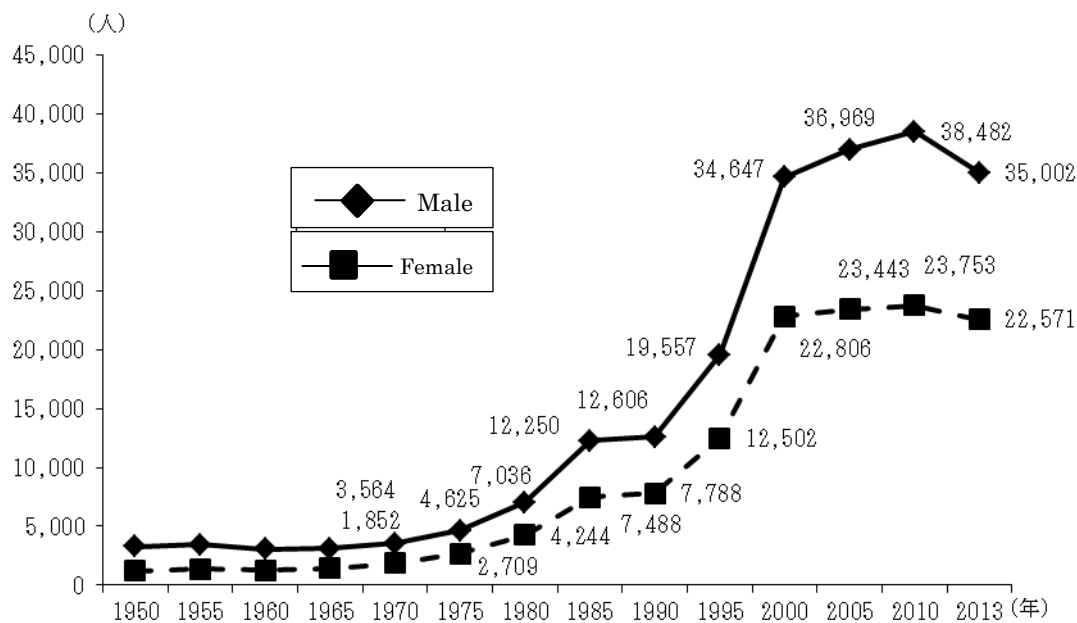
Table 3: Ratio of people at the age of 50 who have never been married

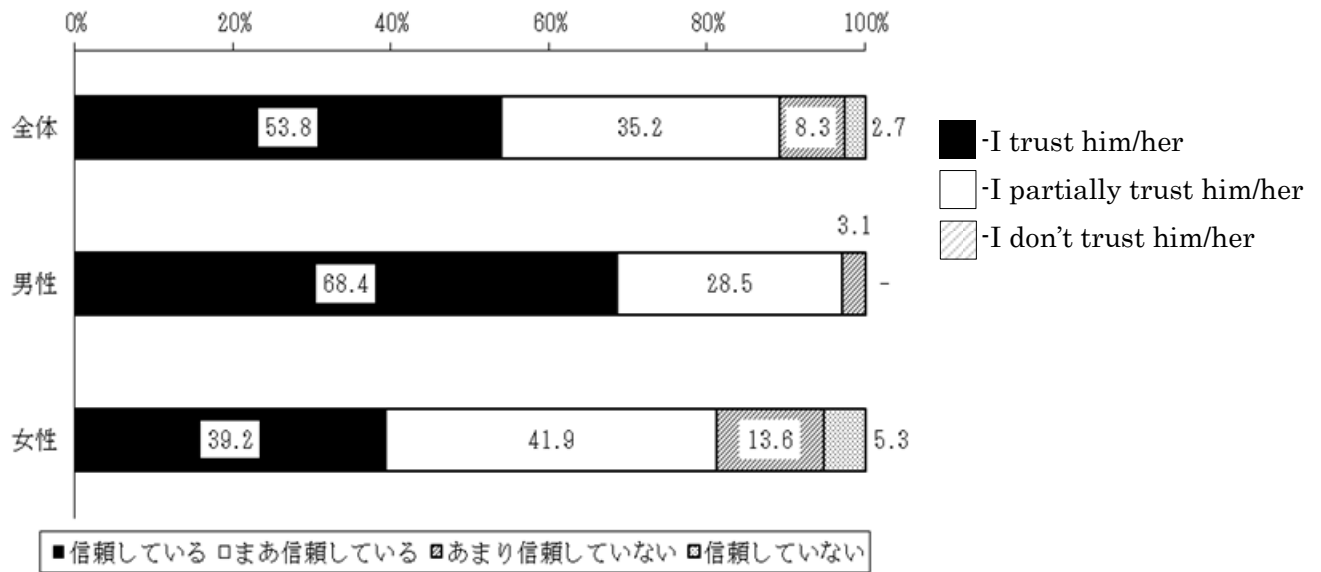
Table 5: Frequency of people aged 60 or over talking with others, including their family
