

Outline of the Fukushima Health Management Survey

The Fukushima Health Management Survey is a project conducted by Fukushima Medical University (FMU) under the initiative of Fukushima Prefecture. Following the release of radioactive materials and evacuation of residents caused by the Fukushima Daiichi nuclear accident, the survey was launched to estimate external exposure of the people in Fukushima Prefecture, which is essential for prevention, early detection and treatment of diseases.

The goal is to protect and promote the long-term health of Fukushima residents.
