- The Tokyo Media Center (TMC) is a separate media coverage base and information provider from the Main Press Center (MPC) and International Broadcasting Center (IBC) established at Tokyo Big Sight. These centres are operated by The Tokyo Organising Committee of the Olympic and Paralympic Games to provide information about the Tokyo 2020 Games to the media. Obtaining the TMC accreditation card will not grant access to the MPC, IBC, or the security areas in the stadiums for the Tokyo 2020 Games. In order to use the TMC facilities, those who hold the accreditation card for the MPC or IBC will have to separately register a TMC account and obtain TMC accreditation.
