1. **Saving Lives**

Daisen, Tottori Prefecture



Daisen offers a serene hiking experience through lush beech forests. Visitors can choose from three distinct trails—Nature, History, and Full Course—each showcasing the area's breathtaking landscapes and rich heritage. A highlight of the area is Ogamiyama Shrine Okunomiya, a tranguil and sacred spot. The shrine is home to Japan's longest natural stone-paved pathway and the country's largest white sandalwood-paved approach, designated as National Important Cultural Properties, making it a must-visit destination for those seeking peace and heritage.

Ama Hut Experience



Toba City's Shima-cho Osatsu in Mie Prefecture is home to Japan's largest community of Ama — traditional female free divers who have upheld this extraordinary practice for over 2,000 years. Deeply woven into the region's cultural fabric, the Ama way of life remains an enduring tradition. Visitors can experience this unique heritage at an 'Ama Hut,' where divers rest before and after their dives, enjoy freshly caught local seafood, and engage in cultural exchanges with the Ama themselves.
